CAMPS 1 and 2

June 21 – 25 for grades 3-6

July 11 – 18 for grades 7-11

The Blaine Girls Basketball Camp is planned to provide instruction in the basic fundamentals of basketball for all skill levels. Our objective will be to teach players the step-by-step techniques that will build basketball skills. The camp will have a high school atmosphere and will focus on improving each player's knowledge of the game of basketball. The instruction is under the direction of the Blaine High School coaches, assisted by varsity and college players. Coach/player ratio will remain low ensuring instruction and individual attention. Camps 1 and 2 are planned for girls entering grades 3-11 in the 2010-2011 school year.

COST

Camp 1 (for grades 3–6) is \$50

Camp 2 (for grades 7–11) is \$50

League cost (for grades 7–10) is \$15

Ballplayers should bring tennis shoes and a basketball (if possible). A T-shirt will be provided by the camp as well as certificates and awards.
